„AIT-Award 2020 | Best of Architecture and Interior“ announced worldwide!

Deadline for entries 17th of December 2019!

The AIT-Award is one of the most prestigious international awards for realized concepts in architecture and interior design. Originating from the contractworld.award, initiated in 2000, the AIT-Award will be awarded for the fifth time and follows on from the past with around 800 submissions from 50 countries.

The AIT-Award is divided into 12 categories, ranging from living through sacred architecture to newcomer, complemented by the special categories of mixed-use and social design.

The international renowned jurors **Walter Angonese** (Angonese Südtirol, IT-Kalern), **Louis Becker** (henning larsen architects, DK-Kopenhagen, inquired), **Ester Bruzkus** (ester bruzkus architekten, DE-Berlin), **Marieke Kums** (Studio Maks, NL-Rotterdam), **Roger Riewe** (Riegler Riewe Architekten, AT-Graz) and **BRUTHER** (FR-Paris, inquired) as well as **Kristina Bacht** (AIT-Dialog, DE-Hamburg) und **Petra Stephan** (AIT, DE-Leinfelden-Echterdingen), will be assigning the AIT-Award, a 2nd + 3rd price as well as special mentions in each category.

Projects completed after the 30th of June 2017 can be handed in by their architects and interior designers until the submission deadline on 17th of December 2019. A maximum of three projects per entrant may be submitted in one or more categories. There is no charge for entering the competition.

The Award ceremony will take place on the 11th March 2020 at the light+building in Frankfurt. All awarded projects will be presented within the context of the award ceremony in an exhibition at the light+building in Frankfurt. Afterwards, this exhibition will move on to our AIT-ArchitekturSalons. A documentation of the prize-winning projects will be featured in an AIT-Dialog special issue.
