A total of 877 projects from 47 countries had been submitted for the **AIT-Award 2020 | Best in Interior and Architecture**, which competed against each other in 14 different categories: Living single-family, Housing multi-family, Hotel, Restaurant, Retail/Trade fair design, Office/Administrations, Health/Care, Sports/Leisure, Public Buildings/Culture, Education, Production/Commercial and Newcomer as well as the special categories Mixed-Use and Social Design/Participatory architecture.

In a closed session on 23rd and 24th January 2020 in Hamburg, the jury selected the 10 to 15 best projects in each category during the first two appraisal tours. In the third round, these entries were discussed again. Finally, the jury determined the projects which should receive awards or special mentions.

The finalists of the **AIT-Award 2020 | Best in Interior and Architecture** are from Austria, Belgium, Brasil, Denmark, Finland, Germany, Italy, Japan, Malaysia, Mexico, Netherlands, Portugal, Slovenia, Sweden, Switzerland, Spain and the US. An overview of the finalists is enclosed in the attachments to this press release.

The rankings will be announced on 11th March 2020 at 4.00 pm by the jurors and the AIT in the context of a festive award ceremony in the presence of the nominated architectural offices and interior designers during the Light + Building in Frankfurt.

During the Light + Building trade fair the awarded projects will be exhibited in the special area of AIT in Hall 1.2, Stand A51 from 8th to 13th March 2020. In the AIT 7/8.2020 all finalists will be published in a special issue of the AIT-Dialog.
