Atmospheric Spaces

Darkness and intermediate forms such as fog, haze and twilight often have a mystical and mysterious character. They are both protective and unsettling in nature. Phenomenology, poetry and magic are indicators of their extraordinary presence. They have a narrative, associative and transcendent effect. Interacting with the geometry of spaces, the perception of space in the dark oscillates between materiality and immateriality, boundaries and openings, proximity and expanse. They are quiet and introverted and contrary to the common architectural striving for light-flooded spaces.

The aesthetics of darkness and its qualities have increasingly receded into the background. One could almost speak of a loss of dark spaces. In future, the dark space may once again take on a more important role in socio-cultural development.

Compared to light, darkness seems like a mass that has to be approached differently in terms of spatial choreography and design in order to stage its qualities. This is challenging and fascinating at the same time. The task is to search for extraordinary, high-quality "dark" spaces staged by composed light incidences in new contexts and to also manifest them in everyday situations.

Your independent, personal idea should be illustrated in the form of individually selected presentation techniques that support the concept, such as visualisations, model photos, collages, drawings, sketches or film sequences. These are to be supplemented with text.

Requirements

As the chosen scholar you will be required to:

1. Join an interview in September 2022 (travel costs will be reimbursed): Meet+Greet with the jury and foundation
2. Submit four blogs within 12 months (texts, illustrations, images, etc.) for online publications on our websites AIT-Architektursalon and Sto-Stiftung
3. Perform or present your work at an exhibition at an AIT-Architecture Gallery or at a worldwide well-known trade show (materials and travel costs will be reimbursed)
4. Be part of an exhibition opening (dates to be announced)

Scholarship

- Total scholarship amount: 24,000 EUR
- Up to 1,000 EUR* of monthly payments for each scholar for one year
- AIT magazine for one year free of charge

**The number of scholars that are chosen depends on the number and quality of the submissions and will be determined by the jury.*

If only two scholars are chosen the monthly grant will be 1,000 EUR, if three scholars are chosen it will be 670 EUR, and in the case of four scholars 500 EUR per month will be paid.

Required application documents

1. Documents (format: DIN A4 (210 x 297 mm, portrait), file type: pdf):

1.2 CV (maximum of 1 page)

1.3 Certificate of enrolment/studies (if available)

1.4 Confirmation that the study duration of at least 1 year remains after scholarship period has begun (July 2022 to June 2023)

1.5 Scan of the interim resport card of the university (if available)

2. Portfolio + Impromptu task (format: DIN A3 (420 x 297 mm, landscape), maximum of 12 pages (further pages will be excluded by the jury, file type: pdf)

Including:

2.1 Portfolio (minimum of 1, maximum of 3 student design projects and if necessary design works outside from school/university), maximum of 8-10 pages. Please note: Only one project can be part of a group work. Please label this project clearly. Also, an appropriate certification for the personal proportion within the group project is required.

2.2 Impromptu task (maximum of 2 to 4 pages)
